The Education Committee will hold a public hearing on Monday, February 26, 2018 at 11:00 A.M. in Room 1E of the LOB.

Please submit 50 copies of written testimony to the Committee staff at the time of sign-up in the First Floor Atrium of the LOB. Public speakers will be determined by a lottery system. Lottery numbers will be drawn from 8:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M. in the First Floor Atrium of the LOB. Public speakers will be allowed to pick up to 3 lottery numbers at a time if they wish to sign up more than one person to testify. Speakers arriving after the completion of the lottery should report to Room 3100 of the LOB and will have their names placed at the end of the speaker list.

**Written testimony must be submitted no later than 9:30 A.M. on Monday, February 26, 2018 to the Committee staff. Testimony received after the designated time may not be distributed until after the hearing. Please submit written testimony in Word or PDF format to [EDtestimony@cga.ct.gov](mailto:EDtestimony@cga.ct.gov).**

Testimony should clearly state testifier name and related Bills. The Committee requests that testimony be limited to matters related to the items on the Agenda. The first hour of the hearing is reserved for Elected Officials, State Agency Heads and Students. The time period from 5:30 P.M. until 6:30 P.M. is reserved for School Superintendents. Speakers will be limited to three minutes of testimony. Bills will be heard in the order listed in the Bulletin. The Committee encourages witnesses to submit a written statement and to condense oral testimony to a summary of that statement. Unofficial sign-up sheets have no standing with the Committee. All public hearing testimony, written and spoken, is public information. As such, it will be made available on the CGA website and indexed by internet search engines.
