What does a program need to know:

- 1. There are a few different types of after school programs in Connecticut
 - a. Licensed Child Care Centers (OEC)
 - b. Licensed Family Child Care Centers (OEC)
 - c. License Exempt School based, School run programs
 - d. License Exempt Municipally run programs
 - e. License Exempt under Statute Programs (BGC, Solar Youth, etc.)
- 2. Licensing takes a while, being prepared before applying helps expedite the process. The OEC has checklists to help those interested in becoming licensed begin and follow the process through various steps including these and many more:
 - a. Organizational policy development
 - b. Sample inspection forms
 - c. Sample agreement forms for required consultants
 - d. New staff orientation checklist
 - e. Request OEC technical assistance
- 3. There are videos from the OEC that help explain:

 - b. Maintaining licensing compliance
 - c. Administration of Medications
